Feb 2nd

The Presentation of the Lord

As Jesus was being presented in the Temple by his parents, Simeon proclaimed Jesus as “a light to reveal God to the nation”. Today is Candlemas Day. Candles will be blessed before the 7.00pm Mass.

Feb 3rd

St Blaise (martyr)

He is associated with the city of Dubrovnik, Croatia, where there is a Basilica in his honour. He died a martyr in 316. Throats will be blessed after Mass on Tuesday. A blessing is a sign of our faith in God's protection, and love for us and for the sick.

Feb 7th

St Mel

As we know, St Mel is the patron saint of our diocese. It is believed he was a Briton who came to Ireland with St Patrick. He is one of the earliest Irish saints. He died in 488.

Saint Brigid

Brigid is renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick. She was born around 454. When she was young her father wished to make a very suitable marriage for her but she insisted in consecrating her life to God. She received spiritual formation probably from St Mel in Ardagh, Co Longford and stayed in Ardagh for a period of time. Other women followed her example and this led her to found a double monastery in Kildare.

She died in 524 and her cult is widespread not only throughout Ireland but in several European countries. The St Brigid's cross, in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian faith, remains a popular sign of God's protection.
