He was taken captive from his home in Wales. He tended sheep on Slemish mountain for six years. He escaped back home at the age of twenty two. After studying in France he returned to Ireland as a bishop in 432. Two writings of his survive:Letter to Coroticus and his Confession written near the end of his life. He died in 491, though other dates have been suggested, 480 or as early as 461.
