Nov.15th St Albert the Great (1206-1280)

A Dominican theologian, he taught theology at Cologne university.

Nov. 16th St Gertrude (1256-1302)

She cultivated devotion to the Sacred Heart and advocated frequent Communion.

Nov. 17th St Elizabeth of Hungary (1207-1231)

Queen at fourteen, widowed at twenty, she was a woman of prayer and service to the poor.

Mother Earth

The American astronaut, **James Irwin**, is one of only twelve men to have walked on the surface of the moon. He was a member of the **Apollo 15** team that went to the moon in **1971**. Later he described the experience of seeing the Earth from outer space.

"In the three days of exploration there were a couple of times when I actually looked up to see the Earth....Earth reminded us of a Christmas tree ornament hanging in the blackness of space. As we got further and further away it diminished in size. Finally, it shrank to the size of a marble, the most beautiful marble you can imagine. That beautiful, warm living object looked so fragile, so delicate, that if you touched it with a finger it would crumble and fall apart. Seeing this has to change a man, has to make a man appreciate the creation of God and the love of God".

As the **COP26** conference in Glasgow comes to a close we are all reminded again that Mother Earth, God's creation, is both beautiful delicate and fragile.
