Mother's Day

Mother's Day was first suggested in 1872 by **Julia Ward Howe** as a day dedicated to peace.

In 1907 a lady from Philadelphia, **Anna Jarvis** began a campaign to establish a national Mother's Day. She persuaded her mother's church in West Virginia to celebrate Mother's Day on the second Sunday of May, the anniversary of her mother's death.

By 1911 Mother's Day was celebrated in nearly every state in the USA. In 1914 president **Woodrow Wilson** proclaimed Mother's Day as a national holiday.

In most European countries Mother's Day is celebrated on the 4th Sunday of Lent, **Mothering Sunday**. That was the day in ancient times when servants were encouraged to visit their mother taking a special cake with them as a gift.
