Not Peace at any Price

In today's Gospel reading **Jesus** tells us that he has come not to establish peace on earth but rather for division. This is a surprise. He also said "*Peace I leave you*, *my peace I give you*" What are we to make of all this?

Peace means different things to different people. To some, peace means that everything is quiet, there are no disturbances, law and order prevail. This may be signs of real peace, but maybe not. Underneath the surface there may be injustice, racism, sexism, economic exploitation, religious discrimination, and many other kinds of oppression. People can get into trouble in some countries for protesting against such abuses.

The command to love our neighbour obliges us to protest against mistreatment and to work for justice. That can cause division. It can even get people thrown into jail. As Christians we cannot settle for peace at any price.
