God Inspired Ambition

In this weekend's Gospel story, we find **Jesus** very disappointed to discover that his disciples were arguing amongst themselves as to which of them was the greatest. They seem to think that being part of Jesus' inner circle would bring them privilege and status.

They wanted power and prestige and it seems, that they wanted it for its own sake. This is the kind of self-centered ambition that **James** talks about in the second reading today when he says "You have an ambition that you cannot satisfy so you fight to get your own way by force." In place of that very worldly ambition, Jesus places before his disciples a very different kind of ambition, an ambition that has the quality of what James in the second reading refers to as "the wisdom that comes down from above." This is God's ambition for all of our lives. It is the ambition to serve. As Jesus says in the Gospel, "Those who want to be first must make themselves last of all." This ambition to serve, again in the words of James in the second reading, is something that "makes for peace and is kindly and considerate, it is full of compassion and shows itself by doing good."
