Feast Days

Nov.: 23rd St Columba

Born around 543, he became a monk at Bangor. With twelve companions he established many monasteries in Europe, the most famous of which was at Bobbio, near Genoa. He died in 615.

Nov.: 24th St Andrew Dung- Lac & Companions

Andrew was one of 117 martyrs who met their death in Vietnam between 1820 & 1864. All were canonized in 1988.

Nov.: 25th St Colman

A bard by profession, he is reputed to have been influenced by St Brendan to become a priest.

Nov.: 27th St Fergal

He was bishop of Salzburg in Germany where he died in 784.

Stir up Sunday

This Sunday, the final Sunday in the church year, we celebrate the feast of **Christ the King**. Sunday next is the first **Sunday of Advent**.

In some Christian traditions the last Sunday is sometimes referred to as "Stir up Sunday". The words of one of the opening prayers of the **Mass** at this time says

"Stir up the will of your faithful. We, pray, O Lord, that, striving more eagerly to bring your divine work to fruitful completion, they may receive in greater measure the healing remedies your kindness bestows"

It's an **Anglican** tradition that on this Sunday families gather in the kitchen to mix and steam the Christmas pudding - Stir up Sunday. Parents teach their children how to mix the ingredients for the pudding. Everyone takes a turn to stir the pudding mix. Each person involved can make a special wish for the year ahead. By tradition the mixture is stirred from east to west in honour of the **Three Wise Men** who visited the Baby Jesus,

"Stir up we beseech O Lord, the will of thy faithful people"
