Not on Bread Alone

The late **Cardinal Basil Hume** of Westminster tells about an incident that happened during his visit to **Ethiopia** during the great famine of the mid 80's. As he got out of the helicopter a small boy aged about 10 came up to him and took his hand. He was wearing nothing but a loin cloth around his waist. The whole time the cardinal was there the child would not let go of his hand. As they went around the boy made two gestures: with one hand he pointed to his mouth, and with the other he took the cardinal's hand and rubbed it on his cheek.

Later the cardinal said "Here was an orphan boy who was lost and hungry. Yet by two simple gestures he indicated our two fundamental needs or hungers. With one gesture he showed me his hunger for food with the other his hunger for love. I have never forgotten that incident and I remember as I boarded the helicopter he stood and looked at me reproachfully."
