Feast Days

Jan. 25thConversion of St Paul

St Paul changed from being a persecutor of Christians into being a teacher and preacher of the peoples. His conversion happened on the road to Damascus.

Jan. 26th Ss Timothy & Titus

They were close to St Paul as followers and later in their work with him.Jan. 28thSt Thomas Aquinas (1224-1274)

This Italian saint is one of the greatest theologians of all time. He is the patron saint of schools and universities.

Jan. 30th St Aiden

St Aiden is an Irish saint of the sixth century. He is associated with Co. Cavan.

On Eagles Wings

This well- known hymn was referred to by **President Joe Biden** on his election as 46 President of the U S A. He said it was a personal and family favourite, a hymn that is a favourite of so many and sung so often at funerals.

The hymn was composed in 1976 by **Fr Jan Michael Joncas**, a priest of the diocese of **St Paul and Minneapolis**, Minnesota. Based on **psalm 91**, said at Sunday Compline, it was written as a song of consolation for Michael's friend, Doug Hall after they had returned from a meal to learn that Doug's father had died. It was first sung at the wake. It has also been sung at funerals of some famous people such as the singer **Pavarotti** in 2007 as well as family funerals. It was sung at the funeral of **Beau Biden**, son of the president who died at the young age of 46.
