Monica had at least 3 children that survived infancy. The oldest Augustine is the most famous. She prayed continuously that Augustine would return to the faith. Her prayers were answered. Augustine not only changed his ways but eventually became a renown theologian and a saint.

## Aug 28<sup>th</sup> St Augustine (354-430)

Son of Monica, he became bishop of Hippo (North Africa) He is a good of the sinner turned saint. Pope Leo is a member of the Augustinian religious order.

## Aug 29th Beheading of John the Baptist

A cousin of Jesus, he was "a voice crying in the wilderness"
