July 1st

St Oliver Plunkett

Oliver Plunkett was born on the 1st of November 1625, near **Oldcastle**, **Co Meath**. He became **Archbishop of Armagh** and the last victim of the Popish Plot. He was martyred on the 1tst of July 1681 at **Tyburn**, London. He was beatified in **1920** and canonized in **1975**, thus becoming the first new Irish saint in almost 700 years.

July 3rd St Thomas (Apostle)

Doubting Thomas is said to have preached the Gospel in India, where he was martyred.
