The Year of St Joseph

Pope Francis has declared a special jubilee year in honour of St Joseph that began on **December 8**th and will end on the same day **2021.** It marks the **150**th anniversary of the proclamation of St Joseph as the **patron of the Universal Church** by pope **Pius 1X** in 1871. This was a difficult time for the Church. The Italian government confiscated much of the Church's property and made the pope effectively a prisoner of the Vatican.

Pope Francis is well known for his devotion to St Joseph. He said the Coronavirus pandemic has heightened his desire to reflect on **St Joseph** since so many people during the pandemic have made hidden sacrifices to protect others, just as St Joseph quietly protected and cared for **Mary** and **Jesus**. "Each one of us can discover in Joseph- the man who goes unnoticed, a daily discreet and hidden presence-an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble" he said.

He said he also wanted to highlight **St Joseph's** role as a father who served his family with charity and humility, adding, "*Our world today needs fathers*."
