# **Love God and Neighbour**

In today's Gospel, Jesus is asked what he believes is the greatest of all the commandments. Jesus replies by quoting from a prayer called the Shema that every faithful Jew recites daily. It said "Hear, O Isreal, the Eternal is our God, the Eternal is one, and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your being and all your might" To this Jesus adds the words "You shall love your neighbor as yourself".

St John describes God in three words "*God is Love*". St Paul reminds us that nothing can separate us from the love of Christ.

The very last lines of the musical **Les Miserables**, poignant and apt for our scripture reading today: As **Jean Valijean** is crossing from death to new life, he utters: "**To love another person is to see the face of God**" **St Augustine** when blessing himself did so in the name of the **Lover** the **Beloved** and the **Love**. **Bishop Fintan Monaghan** (Killaloe).
