# **Feast of the Holy Family**

In the sanctuary we have a copy of the **Holy Family Icon** which will be the centerpiece of the celebrations of **The World Meeting of Families** in Dublin in August 2018.

The icon is in the form technically known as a triptych. It has a larger panel with two smaller panels either side, on hinges.

The **central panel** depicts the **Holy Family** seated at the table celebrating the **Passover Meal**. On the table are the foods associated with the Passover Meal, the bitter herbs and unleavened bread. One side of the table is open suggesting openness to the outsider and that we are invited to take our place with the holy ones.

The panel on the left represents the gospel story of the Raising of Jairus' daughter: reminding us that pain and suffering are part of family life.

The panel on the right represents the story of The Wedding Feast of Cana. The Lord's miracle brought joy to the beginning of a new family.
