# May 5<sup>th</sup> Blessed Edmund Rice (1762-1844)

Born in Callan Co Kilkenny. After the death of his young wife, he sold his possessions and dedicated his life to the education of the poor. To help him in this work, he gathered other like-minded men who took religious vows together to work for the Catholic education of boys. He is a model of patient and cheerful acceptance of the sufferings that come our way.

# May – Mary's Month

The best loved of all prayers to Mary is the **Hail Mary**. It is a very ancient prayer. The original text of the prayer goes back to the tenth century and only at the very end of the Middle Ages (about 1500 AD) the second part - "Holy Mary, Mother of God..." was added.

The prayer is rooted in **St Luke's Gospel** (Luke 1:26 – 56). The voices of the angel **Gabriel** and of Mary's cousin **Elizabeth** come together as they each greet Mary. Gabriel's greeting is "*Rejoice Full of grace! The Lord is with thee*" Elizabeth's is "*Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb*"

It was at the Council of Trent (1568) that the second part of the prayer was added, a petition addressed to Mary, "Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen." At, for many of us sinners, two of the most significant times of our lives – "the hour of our death," and "now."
