TEMPTATION

Today's gospel describes Jesus' temptations in the desert. We are given a glimpse of an inner conflict as he begins his public ministry. At his baptism, Jesus had an experience of God his Father, assuring him that he was his beloved son.

Shortly after his baptism in the Jordan he had a very different experience in the desert, Satan tempting him to take a very different path to the one his baptism had launched him, Satan tempts him to be self-serving- to look out for his own physical needs, to gain followers by indulging in the spectacular, to sell his soul for the sake of power and status.

This was a very real conflict for Jesus. Jesus resolved this inner conflict in favour of remaining faithful to God's call and to the mission God had entrusted to him.

In **Lent**, we try to identify the temptations that are most significant for us; we acknowledge honestly the ways we have surrendered to such temptations and we invite the Lord to enter our lives more fully so that like him we too may be faithful to God's call.
