The Good Shepherd

In today's gospel and in the psalm, we meet a way of talking about God that is very familiar to Christians and Jews: he is described as a **shepherd**, and the people as his **flock**. Shepherds are familiar figures in that part of the Middle East. For us though, pictures of shepherds and sheep don't say much. What is Jesus trying to tell us about himself and God the Father? The shepherd in those days was always on duty, always on the watch, patient, fearless, to keep the sheep from wandering and to protect them from thieves and other dangers.

Jesus was the good shepherd and he laid down his life for us. Those who watch over his followers are called **"pastors**", a latin word meaning "**shepherd**". To be a pastor in our church means to be always on call and ready to serve, to do what Jesus did.- work so that people "might have life and have it more abundantly." **Today is Vocations Sunday.**
