### The Resurrection

In the first century there was a belief in the resurrection of the dead, but this was to occur on the last day, at the end of time. Even though the gospels report Jesus saying that he would rise, it is clear that the disciples did not expect his resurrection in their lifetime. Finding the empty tomb, Mary Magdalene draws a very obvious conclusion that someone has come and stolen the body, for an empty tomb does not prove resurrection. The gospel of John, which we read this week and next, describes two locations for the Easter events, a tomb and a room where the disciples gathered. The message to the disciples, and to disciples of all ages, is that you will not find Jesus in a tomb; he is not among the dead. He is risen, He is alive.
